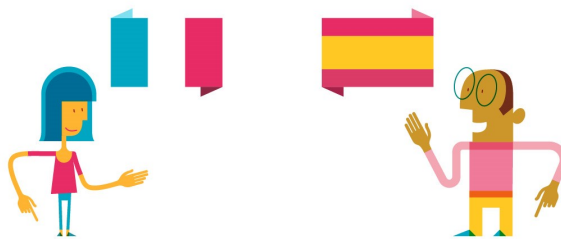

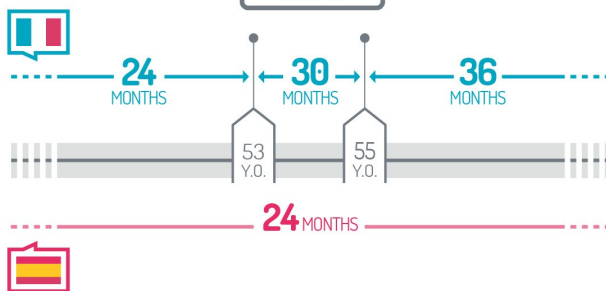


For how long are benefits paid?

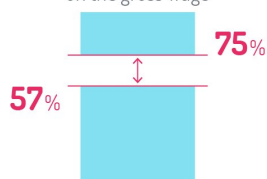

What is the benefit amount?



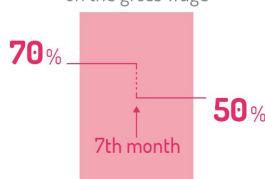
Calculated based on the gross wage
